

## Georgia

### Educational Timeline

- School year: September-June; Graduation occurs in June
- Primary is six years followed by three years of basic/lower secondary school. Upper secondary school consists of three possible tracts: general secondary school (three years), special secondary school (three years), or vocational technical school (two, three, or four year program)

### Group A: Documents That Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Students presenting documents other than those listed below will be evaluated on a case-by-case basis

<i>Sashualo Skolis Atesti</i>	Secondary School Certificate
<i>Sashualo Specialuri Sastsavleblis Diplomi</i>	Special secondary school diploma
<i>Sashualo Ganatlebis Atestati</i>	Certification of secondary education
<i>Prophesiul-Teknikuri Sastsavleblis Diplomi</i>	Vocational-Technical School Diploma (2 or 3 years)
<i>Prophesiul-Teknikuri Sastsavleblis Danartit</i>	Vocational-Technical School Diploma with Supplement (3 or 4 years)

- Must be accompanied by yearly grade reports for each of the academic years of secondary school

### Group B: Documents That Do Not Meet High School Graduation Requirement

Comparable to less than completion of US high school

<i>Arasruli Sashualo Ganatieblis Motsmoba</i>	Certificate of incomplete Secondary Education
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### GPA Calculation

Calculate the cumulative high school GPA by converting line-by-line all final overall exam results listed on the Group A documents listed above. Each grade is weighted equally. Convert to US equivalents and then to quality points. Divide quality points by the total number of examination results included.

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## Class Ranking

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Class rank is evaluated based on a letter written and submitted by the headmaster or principal of the institution from which the student graduated. The letter must confirm both the student's final position in his/her secondary school class and the total number of students in the graduating class (e.g. the student is 41st in a total graduating class of 112 students). However, students completing tracked or separate degree programs (e.g. *Prophesiul-Teknikuri Sastsavlebis Diplomi*) must be ranked against all other students in a given class who completed the same degree program.

## Post-Secondary Education

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Students will be charged terms of attendance and considered transfer students if they have enrolled as a regular student and attended one or more courses at any of the types of institutions listed below (may not be all inclusive) or any other institution that requires proof of high school graduation as a pre-requisite for admission (subject to review on a case-by-case basis).
